Membership in the Junior Board does not discriminate against race, religion, color, national origin, age, sex, physical handicap, political affiliation, medical condition, marital status or gender.

The member must be 13 years of age by opening day of the Arkansas State Fair, but not older than 21 years of age at the time of selection.

A member may serve until age 23 as of January 1.

Section 3.

Upon a vacancy, persons interested in joining the Junior Board must be interviewed at a specified date and time chosen by the Junior Board.

No proxy voting shall be allowed.

Acceptance and membership to the board is an agreement to respect and follow the rules and responsibilities of the Junior Board AND THREE COUNTY FAIR.

Section 3a.

A departing member may choose to continue to serve as an ex-officio, non voting participant on the Junior Board for up to two years immediately following service as a member.

Section 4.

The board will consist of no more than TWELVE (12) MEMBERS (4 PER COUNTY) FROM THE WOODRUFF, CROSS AND JACKSON COUNTIES and the number of new members selected each year will be enough to maintain the board.

Section 5.

All members must attend Three County Fair Board meetings (the 3rd Tuesday of each month at 7 pm). Any member missing two (2) unexcused meetings, in succession, shall have their name placed before the Junior Board for a decision of removal from the board.

At least two-thirds (2/3) of the members must be present to vote on any action. Two-thirds (2/3) majority of those present is required to pass any action proposed to the board.

Members must assist with at least two (2) events during Three County Fair, one of which must be work day, check-in, judging or check-out. Other opportunities to assist include parking,

demolition derby, horse show, pageant, FFA day, parade, livestock show, mud bog, senior citizen day, pet show, bow competition, 4-H/Youth day, youth rodeo and other activities as determined by Three County Fair Board. Junior Board members should report to superintendents or directors of the activity they desire to assist with prior to starting time of said activity.

Junior Board members may also take on additional responsibilities as an assistant superintendent and will report to the superintendent of the department they wish to serve.

The Secretary shall keep records of attendance.

Junior Board members will be provided with a name tag and fair t-shirt to wear when conducting fair business. Before representing Three County Fair in an official capacity, Junior Board members must receive approval from Three County Fair Board and/or the President of Three County Fair Board.

Section 6.

Meetings shall be governed by Robert's Rules of Order.

Article IV Officers

Section 1.

Officers of the Junior Board shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, TO ASSIST THE SAME ON THE THREE COUNTY FAIR BOARD. Any member nominated shall have served on the Junior Board at least one (1) year prior to being nominated for office. Officers shall be selected by secret ballot.

If a member is unable to attend the meeting, they shall notify the President of the Junior Board prior to the meeting if they desire to be nominated for an office. The meeting for reorganization shall be held at the NOVEMBER meeting of the year.

Section 2. President

The President shall preside over all membership and meetings of the Junior Board AND ASSIST THE PRESIDENT OF THE THREE COUNTY FAIR BOARD.

The President shall appoint all committees as deemed necessary from time to time for the good of the Junior Board. The President shall call a special meeting at any time deemed necessary by him or her. A five day notice of such special meeting shall be given by mail, e-mail or text to the members of the Junior Board.

This is a one (1) year term position.

Section 3. Vice President

The Vice President shall serve as the successor to the President and upon completion of the term of Vice President, shall become the President. HE/SHE SHALL ASSIST THE VICE PRESIDENT OF THE THREE COUNTY FAIR BOARD. If a board member is elected to the position of Vice President at the age of 21, he/she will serve an additional year on the Junior Board as President. If the Vice President is unable to assume the Presidency, the board will elect another member of the board to save in that capacity.

The Vice President shall assume the chair position of the nomination committee.

This is a one (1) year position.

Section 4. Secretary

The Secretary shall have charge of all non fiscal records of the Junior Board and mail, e-mail or text all notices to the members of the Junior Board. The Secretary shall assist in the preparation of meeting agenda and be responsible for a complete membership record. HE/SHE WILL ASSIST THE SECRETARY OF THE THREE COUNTY FAIR BOARD.

This is a one (1) year term position with the possibility of re-election and additional terms.

Section 5. Treasurer

The Treasurer shall ASSIST THE THREE COUNTY FAIR BOARD TREASURER. He/She will be in charge of the budget and will attend Fair Board meetings. Treasurer of the Junior Board will not have the authority to sign checks.

This is a one (1) year term position with possibility of re-election and additional terms.

Article V. Committees

Section 1.

The President shall have the power to appoint committees from the Junior Board as deemed necessary for the performance of certain functions.

Any action take by any such committee shall presented for ratification to the Junior Board.

Article VI. General Guidelines

Section 1.

Representatives of the Junior Board are required to participate in fair activities.

Section 2.

Management of the Junior Fair Board shall be the responsibility of the Junior Fair Board and the members of the Junior Fair Board committee.

Section 3.

Members are expected to represent Three County Fair in a professional manner and uphold the reputation of the Junior Fair Board, Three County Fair Board and Three County Fair. Conduct unbecoming of a leader may result in removal from the board.

Section 4.

All Junior Board activities are subject to the approval and authority of the Three County Fair Board.

Article VII Amendments

Section 1.

Notice of a proposed amendment of the by laws must be submitted in writing via mail or e-mail to the membership at least fourteen (14) days prior to a regularly scheduled meeting. The by laws may be altered or amended by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members present.
