2023/2024 THREE COUNTY FAIR RODEO QUEEN COMPETITION

Entry Deadline: September 5th

The Three County Fair Association welcomes contestants from around the state to compete for the Three County Fair Rodeo Queen title. Judging is based on appearance, personality, and horsemanship. This event will take place at Wynne Saddle Club Arena located at the Wynne Sport Complex (801 Glenda Lane, Wynne, AR 72396) on Saturday, September 23rd.

QUALIFICATIONS AND RULES

- 1. Contestants must not be less than 5 or more than 21 years of age as of September 1 of the current year. Ages 5 to 8 will compete as Little Miss, ages 9 to 13 will compete as Princess, ages 14 to 17 will compete as Jr. Queen and ages 18 to 21 will compete as Sr. Queen.
- 2. The contestant must be single; never been married, pregnant and/or had a child.
- 3. The contestant must be a female legal resident of the state of Arkansas.
- 4. The contestant may be amateur or professional. Cannot hold an out of state title.
- 5. Past Arkansas State Fair Rodeo Queens are not eligible to compete again.
- 6. NO STALLIONS ARE PERMITTED.
- 7. Entry constitutes agreement to release Three County Fair Association from all liability.
- 8. All contestants that participate in the Three County Fair Parade on Wednesday, September 20th will be given 5 bonus points on their score sheet. Sashes will be provided to contestants. Let the parade director know you are competing for Rodeo Queen so your participation can be recorded.

CHAPERONES

Contestants under 18 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian or female chaperone appointed by parent/guardian. The chaperone must be present at registration and remain with the contestant throughout the contest.

HORSES

All horses must be accompanied by the original report of negative EIA test within 12 months prior to exhibition.

DRESS REQUIREMENTS

Each contestant should come prepared with enough WESTERN ATTIRE for the event, including an interview session, modeling, impromptu question, and Horsemanship competition. During Horsemanship Competition, contestants can wear their choice of long sleeve western attire and jeans. Hats are required during all phases of the competition, including the interview. Chaps are not allowed. *There will be a Queen run at the end of horsemanship, you will be judged.

SR FREESTYLE HORSEMANSHIP

You're required to execute the following maneuvers:

- 2 large fast circles to the left
- · Simple or flying lead change
- 2 large fast circles to the right
- 2 stops
- Back 1 horse length
- Spins 4 to the right and 4 to the left
- -All bullet points can be done in any order during the pattern.
- -You will have up to 4 minutes to complete your pattern.

-We will gather your music at check-in on September 23rd

JR FREESTYLE HORSEMANSHIP


You're required to execute the following maneuvers:

- 2 large circles to the left
- Simple or flying lead change
- 2 large circles to the right
- 2 stops
- Back 1 horse length
- Spins 2 to the right and 2 to the left
- -All bullet points can be done in any order during the pattern.
- -You will have up to 4 minutes to complete your pattern.
- -We will gather your music at check-in on September 23rd

PRINCESS HORSEMANSHIP PATTERN

Start at A

- 1. Jog from A to B
- 2. Lope around B on the left lead
- 3. Break to an extended the Jog and continue to C 4. Stop at C and back 4 steps



LITTLE MISS HORSEMANSHIP PATTERN

Start at A

- 1. Jog from A to B
- 2. Jog around B
- 3. Extend the Jog to C
- 4. Stop at C and back 4 steps
